STUDENT SUPERVISION

Parents are required to supervise their own children outside before and after school as there is no staff supervision during those hours. Children must be picked up promptly at 2:50 pm. If you are going to be late in picking up your child due to unforeseen circumstances, please inform the school office no later than 2:00 pm. Your child will be asked to wait by the office until you arrive.

KINDERGARTEN

Please remember that school will end at 12:00 the first three weeks of school for all Kindergarten students. For those who need it, daycare will be available in the afternoon. Please sign up through the office by Wednesday, August 29 as we cannot guarantee space after this date. We kindly ask that you only sign up if you are unable to make alternative arrangements as space is limited.

SPIRIT WEAR / PE STRIP

School PE wear is required for grade 4-7 students (t-shirt & shorts). They are optional at the kindergarten to grade 3 level. Orders will be filled promptly and can be picked up at your child's campus. We hope to have stock available for purchase at the Cloverdale Campus in September. You may also buy in person at the Administration Office where all sizes are available for viewing. Cotton and dry-fit options available. Fleece pants and hoodies are available and may be worn to PE classes.

LABEL YOUR CHILD'S CLOTHING

Please label your child's clothing. Every year the Lost & Found overflows with beautiful jackets, hoodies, sweaters etc. and because they are not labelled, and not claimed, they end up at the thrift store. If you label your child's clothing and it gets misplaced, it will be returned to them.

EXTRA SET OF CLOTHING

Students in grades K-3 are required to have a complete extra set of clothing, including socks and underwear, in a separate bag. Please label the bag and each item with your child's name.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES are provided by the school. Please note the following:

- **Netbooks:** Grade 7 students are required to have a netbook/laptop. You can purchase one through the school for \$500 or provide your own.
- **Bibles:** Beginning in September 2018 grade 4 students at the Cloverdale Campus will receive an NIV Adventure Bible from the school with the expectation that they continue to use that bible through grade 7.
- **Middle Campus Music** class information will be sent home with grade 4-7 students in the first week of school.
- **Earthquake Kits** are required for both primary and middle campus. Please see enclosed Comfort Kit letter for more information.
- **Students are to have both indoor and outdoor shoes.** Indoor shoes should be non-scuff and suitable for PE activities. Flip flops, high heeled runners and thin slip-on runners are not suitable for indoor or outdoor activities. Skates, skateboards or shoes with wheels are not allowed.

PARKING LOT: Parents are responsible for their vehicle and their children. Please do not let your child run through the parking lot; walk with them and be aware that children are everywhere. Please be cautious.

- Absolutely no cell phone usage while driving in parking lot
- Please travel in counter-clockwise direction in the gravel parking lot.
- Traffic circle is for pick up and drop off only—do not leave cars unattended.
- Please do not leave young children in car while you go into school to pick up students
- Do not cut behind cars that are backing in
- Be patient
- Follow people directing traffic
- Maximum 10 km/hr in parking lot
- Wait until you are parked to let your child out of the car
- Please turn off your engine while you wait
