### TUITION NOTES:

Surrey Christian School strives to provide a competitive tuition structure balancing the needs of our community with our financial obligations of providing an excellent education. Tuition is reviewed annually to ensure we are continuing to provide an excellent education at an affordable price.

A portion of your tuition is treated as a donation by CRA. A tax receipt will be issued in February each year based on tuition paid and the number of children enrolled at the school.

Early payment discount of 1.5% if full amount of tuition paid first week of school in September.

Students taking 5+ courses at secondary level are considered full time for the purposes of tuition.

### ADDITIONAL FEES:

1. Non-refundable application fee of \$200.
2. Upon acceptance the first month's tuition as a non-refundable deposit.
3. Bus fees are listed on the reverse of this page. Riding the school bus is optional.
4. Students entering grades 7-12 are required to purchase a Netbook for \$500.
5. Additional activity fees for each grade are listed on the reverse of this page.
6. Consult the secondary campus [course calendar](#) for additional costs arising in individual courses.
