Information for the start of the 2018-2019 school year.

CLASS LISTS for kindergarten through grade 7 will be posted on our website and on the front doors of the school at 3:00 pm on Friday, August 31. For security reasons, only the child's first name and the initial of the last name will be posted. It is a fairly complex procedure to place students into classes. We take into account the following factors:

- male/female ratios in classes
- students learning needs
- academic abilities
- emotional/social needs
- relational/ friendship needs and wants
- teacher recommendations

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL SCHEDULE

8:20 am Grades K-3: New families can enter through main entrance at 8:20
Grades 4-7: All students can enter through front doors after 8:20

8:35 am First bell rings

8:45 am School begins

12:00 pm Dismissal

MON-THURS SCHOOL SCHEDULE

8:35 am First bell rings (K-3 students wait outside for the first bell to ring)

8:45 am School begins

12:35 pm Lunch begins

2:50 pm Dismissal (Parents are required to pick up their child promptly at 2:50)

STUDENT SUPERVISION

Parents are required to supervise their own children outside before and after school as there is no staff supervision during those hours. Children must be picked up promptly at 2:50 pm. If you are going to be late in picking up your child due to unforeseen circumstances, please inform the school office no later than 2:00 pm. Your child will be asked to wait by the office until you arrive.

LABEL YOUR CHILD'S CLOTHING

Please label your child's clothing. Every year the Lost & Found overflows with beautiful jackets, hoodies, sweaters etc. and because they are not labelled, and not claimed, they end up at the thrift store. If you label your child's clothing and it gets misplaced, it will be returned to them.

EXTRA SET OF CLOTHING

Students in grades K-3 are required to have a complete extra set of clothing, including socks and underwear, in a separate bag. Please label the bag and each item with your child's name.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES are provided by the school. Please note the following:

- **Netbooks:** Grade 7 students are required to have a netbook/laptop. You can purchase one through the school for \$500 or provide your own.
- **Bibles:** Grade 4 students and new students in grade 5, 6 and 7 will receive an NIV Adventure Bible from the school. Returning grade 5, 6 and 7 students should bring the NIV Adventure Bible they received in grade 4.
- **Binders** may be requested by the classroom teacher for grade 4-7 students.
- **Middle Campus Music** class information will be sent home with grade 4-7 students in the first week of school.
- **Earthquake Kits** are required for both primary and middle campus. Please see enclosed Comfort Kit letter for more information.
- **Students are to have both indoor and outdoor shoes.** Indoor shoes should be non-scuff and suitable for PE activities. Flip flops, high heeled runners and thin slip-on runners are not suitable for indoor or outdoor activities. Skates, skateboards or shoes with wheels are not allowed.

PARKING LOT: Parents are responsible for their vehicle and their children. Please do not let your child run through the parking lot; walk with them and be aware that children are everywhere. Please be cautious.

- Please respect “no parking” signs on the west side of 162nd street directly across from the school.
- Please respect crossing guard and never try to “beat” a stop sign. All parents and children need to cross at the crossing guard station.
- When walking to the primary building from the street or top of parking lot, use the sidewalk along the middle building. Do not use the parking lot as a walk way to or from the primary building.
- Parking lot:
 - Absolutely no cell phone usage while driving in parking lot
 - Please back into your stall if possible
 - Do not cut behind cars that are backing in
 - Be patient
 - Follow people directing traffic
 - Maximum 10 km/hr in parking lot
 - Wait until you are parked to let your child out of the car
 - Please turn off your engine while you wait
