There are many opportunities for students to be involved in extracurricular athletics at both secondary and elementary campuses. Many of the volleyball and soccer teams at the secondary campus begin tryouts within the first few days of school. **It is important for your child to watch the daily announcements for date, time and location of those tryouts so they do not miss out on these opportunities.**

Athletic fees are paid online through a very secure site that many high schools in BC use called "Karelo". An email will be sent to you after your child has made the team requesting payment. This is where you will also sign off on the "Assumption of Risk" form acknowledging the risks associated with that sport. Secondary fees shown below do NOT include cost of transportation and hotels/food for trips outside the lower mainland.

SECONDARY CAMPUS AWARDS CELEBRATION

We desire to honour all students who participate in Falcons Athletics, by encouraging them to develop five important characteristics: Commitment, coachability, development of athletic ability, sportsmanship and leadership. We hope and dream to honour each athlete's progress as they move through the grades by presenting them with medallions to mark their progress in these five areas.

Near the end of the school year we host our annual athletic dessert evening where we invite all parents, student-athletes and coaches to reflect on the athletic year that was, and honour the students with their accomplishments. Awards are earned based on the following point system.

Major sport participation earns a maximum of 10 points, while minor sports can earn a maximum of 6. Additional points are awarded for provincial championship participation and success. At the end of each season of play we ask for input from the coaches when assigning points. They evaluate our players in the following areas:

- Coachability /2
- Sportsmanship /2
- Commitment /2
- Leadership /2
- Athletic ability /2

Falcon Awards: These points accumulate over time (grade 8-12) and contribute to earning the following awards:

- Bronze Medallion (30-49 points)
- Silver Medallion (50-69 points)
- Gold Medallion (70-89 points)
- Small Plaque (90-109 points)
- Large Plaque (110 or more points)
