

LEADERSHIP 11/12

Credits: 4

Purpose: This course will teach and train students to become leaders in redemptive restoration. It will provide students with opportunity to lead the student body in activities (events, dances and the like), service and in building community. Students will be challenged to reflect on their own leadership strengths and weaknesses as they discover characteristics of servant leadership. Students in this course will be a part of the student leadership team, similar to student council, with added responsibility. Students in Leadership 12 will be required to carry out one or more major leadership project with little to no assistance from the teacher. Students in Leadership 11 will be required to carry out one or more major leadership project with assistance from the teacher.
