

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Purpose: To provide individualized instruction to students for whom the regular course work is not appropriate.

To help the student develop their God-given gifts and to grow in their knowledge and love of God, to increase reading, writing and math skills and to prepare students for life after High School by teaching practical skills and by providing work experiences. Students are integrated into the regular class with peers as much as possible. In accordance with the goals of his/her I.E.P. students in the Special Education Program will finish high school with a BC School Completion Certificate.

Outline: Courses will be individualized to meet the needs of the student. Life skills and work experience can be included in the program.

Skills Developed: Increase reading and writing ability, acquire more knowledge and skills necessary to hold down a job and to acquire skills necessary to live in the "real" world.

Assignments: Depends on courses taken

Expected Homework: Depends on courses taken

Materials Required: binders, pens, pencils, pencil crayons, etc.

Prerequisite: Demonstrated need through testing or teacher recommendation.
