

YOUTH WORK IN TRADES 11/12

Credits: 16

Purpose: The Youth Work in Trades program provides students with the opportunity to be registered as apprentices and complete 480 hours of workplace-based training with approved employers. The program enables students to get a head start on the trade training they plan to pursue after graduation.

Requirements: Students must have an interest in and a commitment to a particular trade discipline. Students will be required to complete an application package (which includes a minimum 30 hour work experience). Students must provide their own transportation.

Expected Homework: Students have to record their hours in a work log.
